

## INFORMATION CLAUSE

1. Regarding the organization of the 17th International Polish Championships of Children from Care Homes in Football "Hope for Mundial" please be informed that the data controller for the personal data of children, their legal representatives, guardians, coaches, and other individuals involved in the event is Stowarzyszenie Kultury Fizycznej "VITA ACTIVA," with its registered office at ul. Zerzeńska 33, 04-787 Warsaw, [biuro@nadziejnamundial.pl](mailto:biuro@nadziejnamundial.pl), which determines the purposes and methods of processing this data.

3. The controller processes personal data to enable participation in the event and its proper organization, as well as for ongoing communication related to the organization and conduct of the Championships, based on:
  - a) the Regulations accepted by you (Article 6(1)(b) of the General Data Protection Regulation; hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"), including specifically for participant registration, application verification, competition organization, and ensuring the proper conduct of the event;
  - b) expressed consent for the processing of personal data (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR), and in the case of special categories of data – explicit consent for their processing (Article 9(2)(a) of the GDPR);
  - c) the controller's legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR), specifically for fulfilling obligations arising from the agreement between the Controller and the Ministry of Sport and Tourism (hereinafter "MST") concerning funding under the "Aktywni – zadanie nr 4. Aktywni Międzynarodowo" program, which means personal data may be transferred to MST to the necessary extent;
  - d) the controller's legitimate interest in establishing, pursuing, or defending against any potential claims related to participation in the Championships (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR);
  - e) the controller's legitimate interest in processing data for archival and documentation purposes related to the organization of the Championships (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR);
  - f) where consent has been given for the use of image – based on Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR and Article 81 of the Act of February 4, 1994, on Copyright and Related Rights.
  - g) if appropriate consent is given – for promotional, informational, marketing, or commercial purposes related to the controller's activities (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR);
  - h) the controller's legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) in managing the Championships' profiles and the controller's activities on social media and online platforms (such as Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, or TikTok), specifically to provide updates on the event, promote it, and build and maintain a community related to football, as well as to communicate with users through the available functionalities of these services.
4. Recipients of personal data may include entities to whom the controller transfers data in connection with the organization and execution of the Championships, based on applicable legal provisions or concluded agreements. Specifically, these may include:
  - a) the Ministry of Sport and Tourism – for data necessary to implement and settle the event's funding, and for image data, solely based on separately given consent;

- b) other public authorities authorized to obtain data under legal provisions, especially in connection with ongoing proceedings;
  - c) external entities supporting the controller in providing services, such as those providing IT services, performing consulting, legal, or auditing services, or collaborating with the controller on promotional activities and marketing campaigns,
  - d) entities responsible for the event's safety and operations, such as security, medical teams, and private security firms – but only to the extent required for them to perform their duties.
5. Data will only be transferred as far as necessary to achieve specific objectives and while maintaining appropriate security measures.
  6. Personal data will be processed throughout your participation in the Championships. After the event concludes, it will be processed for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, specifically:
    - a) until the statute of limitations expires for any potential claims arising from participation in the Championships (for a maximum of 6 years),
    - b) for the period mandated by law, including the time required for the implementation and settlement of the co-financing agreement under the "Aktywni – zadanie nr 4. Aktywni Międzynarodowo" program.
    - c) until consent is withdrawn – for data processed based on your consent, particularly for promotional and marketing activities,
    - d) for as long as materials published on social media platforms (such as Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, or TikTok) remain active, in line with the operating policies of those websites,
    - e) for the duration required for archival and documentation purposes, including the recording of Championship results (e.g., the makeup of winning teams).
  7. Regarding the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights:
    - a) the right to access your data and obtain a copy of it,
    - b) the right to rectify (correct) your data,
    - c) the right to erase your data, in circumstances permitted by law,
    - d) the right to restrict the processing of your data,
    - e) the right to data portability,
    - f) the right to object to data processing,
    - g) the right to withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing performed before its withdrawal,
    - h) the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if it is believed that data processing violates the provisions of the GDPR.
  8. While providing personal data is voluntary, it is a necessary condition for participating in the Championships.
  9. Personal data will not be transferred to a country outside the European Economic Area (a third country) or an international organization.
  10. Personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
